

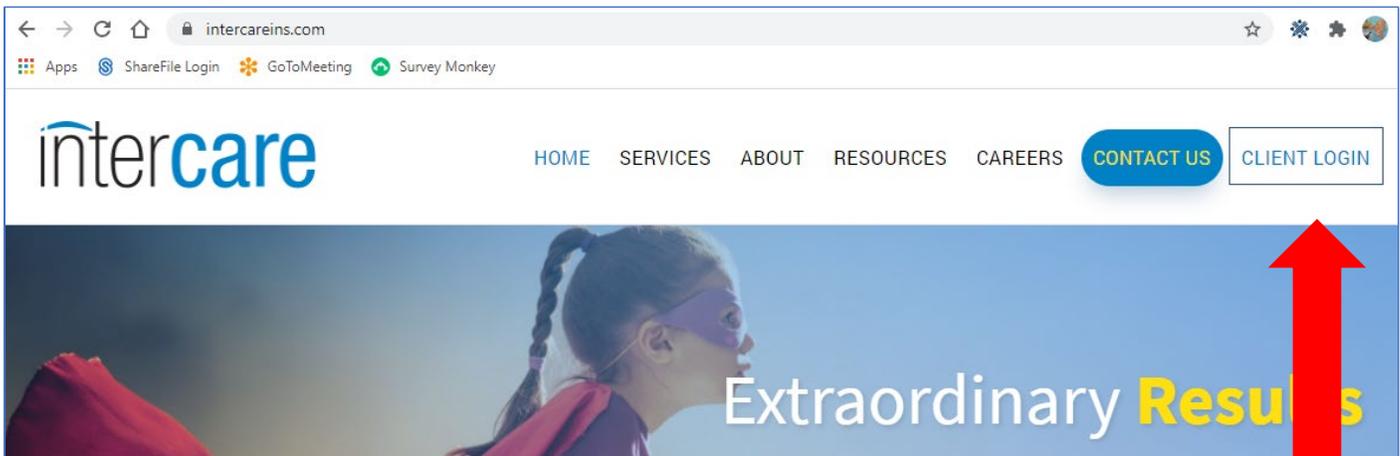

- All requests for a login are validated by Intercare’s account management team.
- To expedite the validation and set up process, please follow the guideline above for Company (Sonoma County), Employer (Your Department—i.e. DHS, HSD, SHF, CDC, WTR etc) and Carrier (Intercare),
- When you are ready to submit the form, select the blue “Request Access” button at the bottom of the form to submit your request.

Once you request your login, Intercare’s IT Department will set up your appropriate access and send you your login credentials via “**ICare Help**” (icarehelp@intercareins.com). Be on the lookout for this secure email, as you will need to click on it and follow the steps. **Please note this is NOT a phishing email.** It is a legitimate e-mail from Intercare which you can verify by looking for the e-mail address listed above.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you do not receive the e-mail from “ICare Help” within 48 hours of requesting access, you may need to log into Outlook 365 in your internet browser (rather than your desktop Outlook application) to see the message. The default Outlook 365 link is: "<https://outlook.office365.com/mail/>". It should automatically log you in with your Sonoma County credentials if you're on a County computer. Otherwise, log in with your current County email/password.

If it has been 48 hours since you registered, you have checked Outlook 365, and have still not received the message, kaci.knierim@sonoma-county.org.
