AI Due Diligence and Compliance Review, The Information Systems Department (ISD) and County Counsel have reviewed the following technologies for security and compliance, to ensure data protection, legal compliance, and adherence to County policies.

Conditions for Use

- All technologies must be used in accordance with Administrative Policy 9-6 Information Technology Artificial Intelligence (AI) Policy.
- All technologies must be used in accordance with any Local Agency/Department policies, standards, guidelines, and procedures (if any exist).
- Users must obtain approval from their Local Agency Department Head/General Manager before using any of these technologies.
- All Requirements for Use noted below for each technology must be followed.
- Any configurations or uses that do not follow all these conditions are not permitted and must be reviewed further by County Counsel.

Although due diligence has been performed on these technologies, the use of AI technologies within each department must still be authorized by the Local Agency Department Head/General Manager, so consult with your Local Agency Department Head/General Manager before using them.

Costs associated with these technologies are the responsibility of each Local Agency/Department, so review the fiscal impact on your agency/department before implementing them.
