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INDUSTRIAL HEMP REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

This checklist is a reference tool only and is not proof of registration. Do not plant or cultivate industrial hemp until registration has been approved. Any planting or cultivation before registration is approved may result in crop destruction and violations for unpermitted cannabis cultivation.  - Type: new or renewal; if renewal, previous registration number noted
 - Registrant information
 - Business information
 - Key participant information
 - Criminal history report for each key participant
 - Cultivation site(s)/cultivar information, including number of total sites and site numbers
 - Map showing boundaries of each cultivation site
 - Documentation to meet 3 CCR § 4920 for each cultivar (Grower Application only)
 - Variety development plan (Breeder Application only)
 - CDFA nursery license N/A
 - Signature, printed name, title, and date
- \$900 CDFA annual registration fee via check or money order only payable to *CDFA Cashier*

Upon submission of registration application materials and fees, applicant will receive a *Confirmation of Industrial Hemp Registration Application Submission*. The confirmation is not proof of registration. Applicant will be notified if registration has been approved.
