Worker evaluates (Source: State Dept of Social Services 1990) periodically to determine need for ongoing services. **Detention Hearing** Held within one Court day of filing the petition. Judge decides if further custody is urgently needed or if child can be released safely to parents. Jurisdictional Hearing Held within 10 Court day of detention hearing. Judge weighs evidence and decides to either make the child a dependent of the Court or releases child to parents. Dispositional Hearing Court hears evidence, decides what is necessary to further protect child and resolve problems that brought the family to Court. ▲ Judge dismisses case Court-Ordered Family Maintenance Family Reunification Families remain together; parents receive services and participate in Child placed outside home in foster care.
